2009 Rule Updates:

- Helmets will not be worn by any players.
- Three point stance will not be allowed; only two point stance will be allowed.
- If a block is attempted and the opposing player is hit in the face or below the belt, the official will penalize the player by having them retire from the game for the length of time that it takes for the coach to talk to them about what they did wrong and how to block properly. If a player is sent out three or more times, they will not be allowed to play the remainder of the game.
- No punting or kicking - The offensive team takes possession of the ball at its 5-yard line. If the offense fails to score, the ball changes possession and the new offensive team takes over on its 5-yard line.
