Rules and Regulations

1. The National Federation of High School Volleyball Rules will govern play.
2. Game time is forfeit time. Teams must have at least five players ready to play at game time or the match will be forfeited.
3. Teams shall change courts after each game.
4. Substitutes may enter the game only in the center-back position unless an injury occurs.
5. Each match will consist of three rally scoring games to 23 points with a 25 point cap. Games must be won by two.
6. Spiking is allowed.
7. The ball may touch the net during service.
8. Each team must supply a person to be a line judge for each match.
9. We recommend that players carry their game shoes in to the gym to help keep the playing surface clean.
10. **Jewelry may not be worn.**
