**Consent Agenda:**

Item (b), change order for Route T bore and jack project:: Staff stated that this item needs to be removed from the agenda, and it will be put on the August 15 agenda instead.

**Informal Calendar:**

2005-22: Councilman Jonathon Schnitzler stated this will come off to be voted on and explained what the substitution #2 will accomplish. Councilman Kenneth Ferguson wanted to know if all the bar owners affected by this were sent copies of the latest versions. A lengthy discussion was held regarding this issue.
