**BILLS INTRODUCED**

**2003-63:** Jim Hartley stated that staff is going to request an amendment to this bill to change it to say "other parking fees."

**NEW BUSINESS**

The issue of manhole covers was brought up, and Councilman Angle felt that discussions need to be held because of some recent problems that citizens are concerned about.

Councilman Richard Groner had questions about the letter distributed from B. J. Jones regarding the Rock Hill Road rezoning issue. He wanted to know if a new fee was paid,

which, in his opinion, would make it a new issue. He stated if no new fee was paid, then they would be considering the old issue.
