

PARK IMPROVEMENTS



OAK HILLS GOLF CENTER EXPANSION

The next phase of the long term Oak Hills Golf Center master plan is underway. Park crews are combining old #16 and #17 into a new and challenging par 4 hole. The new hole will feature zoysia tee box, zoysia fairway, USGA style green, double row fairway irrigation, two fairway sand bunkers, one green side sand bunker and continuous concrete cart path.

The new hole is scheduled to open late summer/early fall 2010 to allow for the warm season turf to grow-in over the summer months. We are excited to offer another fun and challenging golf hole at the Oak Hills Golf Center.

NORTH JEFFERSON CITY RECREATION AREA - TEE BALL/COACH PITCH BALL FIELDS

The construction of two new tee ball/coach pitch ball fields in the North Jefferson City Recreation Area is complete and opened for league play June 1, 2009. The two new fields have smaller infields and are designed for younger children playing tee ball and coach pitch baseball/softball. These new fields are located adjacent to the North Jefferson City outdoor pavilion at the east end of 4th Street.

Spectators are always welcome and JCRC members can assist in learning more about radio-control flight. During the warmer months you may find R/C instructors giving lessons on Thursday evenings. To fly at the site you must be a member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA), which provides liability insurance. Join JCRC to obtain a current Flying Field Permit and Club membership card.

JCRC typically hosts two R/C events each year. In the spring you can watch R/C airplanes fly from the water at the annual Float Fly. In the fall you can check out all types of R/C helicopters at the annual
