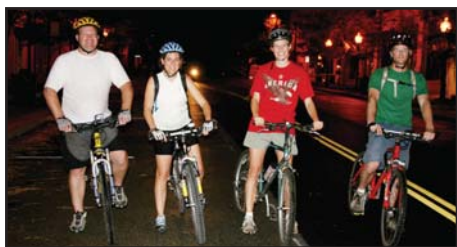


## TOUR DE JEFF CITY
